- * Always remember- we become caring people by doing caring things.


We will continue to spread kindness and caring in the months ahead. How will you show caring and kindness?



Girls on the Run is an afterschool program like no other!

Twice per week for 10 weeks, participants will have fun, make friends, increase their physical activity levels and learn important life skills. Trained and caring coaches lead 3rd - 5th grade girls through interactive lessons and movement activities. The season ends with a celebratory 5K event at De Anza Cove on May 7, 2023!

Participating in Girls on the Run transforms girls' lives by helping them increase their self-confidence, develop healthy relationships, and feel good about themselves, inside and out.



Girls who were the least active at the start of the program increased their physical activity by more than 40%*


