➤ Approval of Minutes	 Action Item: Approval of minutes for October 6, 2021 meeting: SSC Co- Chairperson- Heather Allan 	 Monica Morelli made a motion to approve the October 6, 2021 minutes. Cindy Davis seconded the motion. Motion passed 8-0. 	

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Attendance Data review (October 2021)	Information Item, Linda Trousdale, Principal	• Discussion- We looked at the data for the month of October. Our attendance rate for the last month was 92.22% and year to date attendance is 92.99%. Additionally we reviewed attendance rates by race/ethnicity. Our two lowest attendance rates were for scholars identiife3d as Hispanic (89.4%) and scholars identiified as Multi-racial (92.3%). When we looked at attendance by grade levels we saw that it was a more even attendance rate. Our lowest grade for attendance was Kindergarten (91.4%) and our highest was grade five at (94.8%). We are not focusing on incentives currently, as scholars must remain out if they have COVID-like symptoms.

3. Data Review		
Fountas& Pinnell (grades TK-2)	Information- Linda Trousdale, Principal	Discussion —The SSC reviewed the Overall data as well as the individual grade level data. Mrs. Trousdale explained that TK and K data looks different because of the level they need to score at to be AT or ABOVE grade level. We also discussed that this is a new assessment and it is more complex than the previous DRA that we used. The books are longer and more is on each page as you go up through the levels.

• FAST Bridge Reading (grades 3 rd -5 th)	Information- Linda Trousdale, Principal	 Discussion Grade 3- Advanced 18 scholars = 66% Low Risk 6 scholars = 22% Some Risk 2 scholars = 7% High Risk 1 scholar = 3% Grade 4 Advanced 8 scholars = 24% Low Risk 14 scholars = 44% Some Risk 5 scholars = 16% High Risk 5 scholars = 16% Grade 5 Advanced 8 scholars = 35% Low Risk 5 scholars = 25% Some Risk 6 scholars = 30% High Risk 1 scholar = 5% The review of the data aligns with our decision to focus literacy acceleration and intervention with our older scholars first.

Review of current funds	➤ Information- Linda Trousdale, Principal	Discussion – the SSC reviewed the current budget. Discussed that additional funds were allocated to the school for extra supports for learning loss and health and safety. These funds currently appear in the red, yet we are still fine. The processing has not caught up with the expenses yet.

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6. DAC and ELAC DAC Report	> Informational- Cindy Davis, DAC representative	 Mrs. Davis had provided links to documents from the DAC. They gave background on the Superintendent Search Committee, LCFF, LCAP and more. There was discussion about electing a new DAC board at the next meeting and that you could submit nominations for the positions. Pamela King from Family Engagement spoke about resources for Mindfulness. You can find the resources at sdusdfamilies.org LCAP update. They are trying to realign the timelines. One provides input at the end of the year and they are looking at switching this. In addition, input from Town Halls is difficult because each one focuses on a specific LCAP goal and in order to understand it all you have to attend multiple meetings. There was a presentation about Summer School and Summer Experience. They had many scholars participate. It was harder for parents of the elementary ages to find additional enrichment programs. Many were for older or younger scholars than our population.

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		 Nominations will be voted on for the DAC board at the meeting in November. They are looking at ways to continue to have online meetings for DAC and SSC. There is a group meeting about this and if you would like to join contact them at dac.sdusd@gmail.com Title 1 presentation- discussed budget changes and the accountability piece. Mrs. Trousdale shared that we have seen that shift for us as we use the Title1budget for items. There are extra steps now required by Miss Darla. DAC shared that they are also trying to change timelines for 2022-2023 for Principals and sites. DAC presentation was a recap of the roles and function of the DAC.
